At this time the Court heard presentation of Steve Sparks, with Aquatic Recreational Specialties, LP, regarding improvements at County Parks in Kermit and Wink.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wolf and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the County Auditor be authorized to advertise for bids for site preparation, children's spray park, pool deck equipment, landscaping, fencing and signage, walking trails, concession building and restrooms in County Park in Kermit and park pavilion in County Park in Wink. Said bids are to be received until 10:00 o'clock A.M., Monday, December 20, 2010; which motion became an order of the Court upon the following vote:

Winkler County E.M.S is requesting funds to purchase a Kohler 16kw natural gas emergency standby generator.

Winkler County E.M.S. operates a crew on-duty and a crew on backup 24 hours a day. The on-duty crew is required to stay at the station and the backup crew must report to the station anytime the on-duty crew must leave the Kermit city limits for a 911 response or out of county Inter-facility transfer. This station was built in 2007 but a funding shortfall at the time meant installation of an emergency standby generator had to be postponed. When power is lost garage doors must be left open, battery chargers for equipment, portable radios and vehicles stop working and ambulance environmental units stand idle. In addition the radio base station, phones, computers, heat and air conditioning for the station is inoperable. In the three years we have occupied this station power has been lost multiple times due to storms, wind, ice buildup and other reasons beyond our control.

Installation of this generator would allow Winkler County EMS to operate all equipment and the station indefinitely until normal power can be restored.

The price for a turnkey installation of the generator, all needed supply lines, equipment and accessories is \$7,500. A quote is attached.
