## DSHS Public Health Region (PHR) 9/10 Vaccine Information

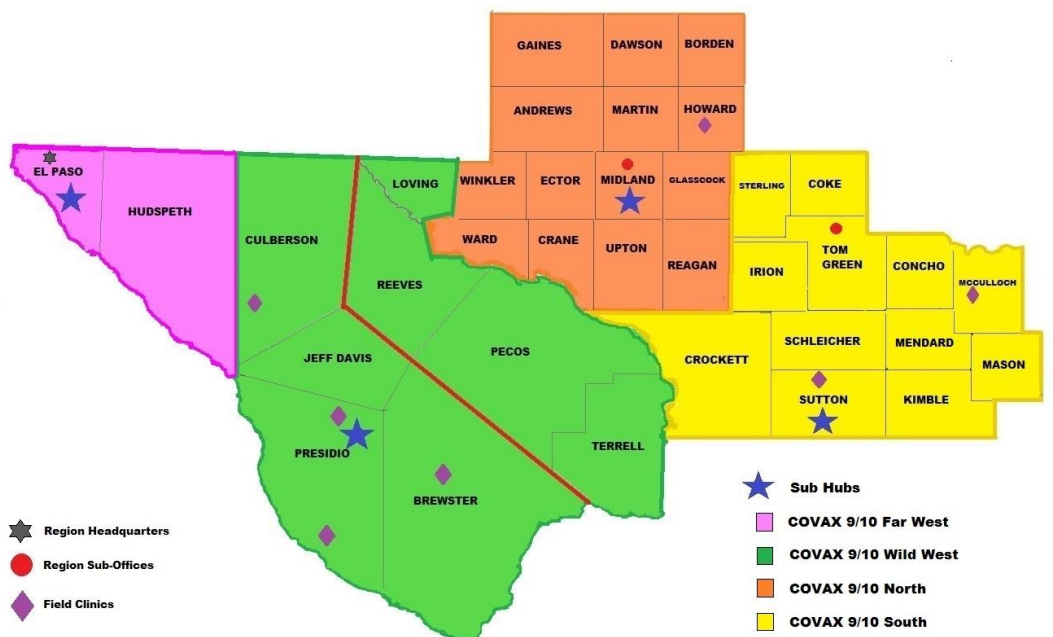
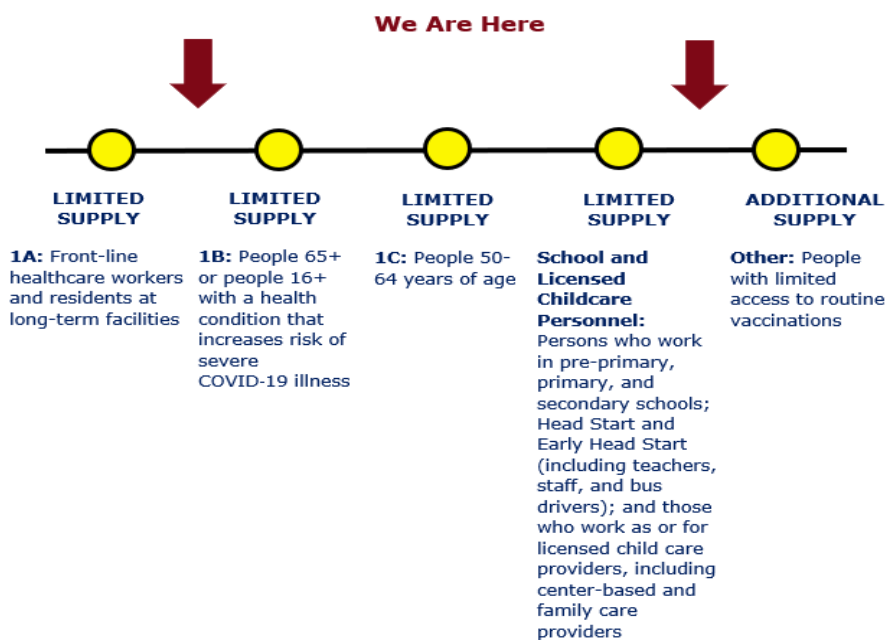

We are aware there is a high volume of people who want to get vaccinated against Coronavirus (COVID-19). Since the announcement that all adults are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine in Texas, vaccine supply has been limited. However, we are working hard to get people vaccinated by priority population-order, beginning with people 80 years old or older when scheduling appointments and accommodate anyone in that age group who presents for vaccination.

There are several ways to register to get vaccinated. Please feel free to sign on to any and all of these registration sites that pertain to you. Vaccination Providers are tracking the second doses to be sure people get complete vaccination series.
